RE: REQUEST FOR REVIEW BY THE SPECIAL PROCUREMENT OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE (SPOC): TENDER NUMBER COG/FA/03/05/2024 - PROCUREMENT OF STATIONERY USING FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT

Your minute dated 15 August 2024 refers.

At the Special Procurement Oversight Committee (SPOC) Meeting No.30 of 2024 held virtually on 5 September 2024; Members observed the following:

- The Accounting Officer's procurement process was for the Procurement of Stationery under Framework Agreement and subsequent call-offs contract.
- The Accounting Officer adopted the Framework Agreement method in line with section 21(2) and section 30 of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (PPDPA) Act [Chapter 22:23] as read with section 11 of the PPDPA (General) Regulations whereby suppliers will be engaged through calloff orders on an as and when required basis at varying prices.
- The Accounting Officer advertised the tender in line with section 38 (2) of the PPDPA Act and received a sole response.
- The Accounting Officer was recommending to cancel the tender due to non-responsive bid in view with section 42(1) (d) of the PPDPA Act, which reads, "if possible, a procuring entity shall avoid cancelling procurement proceedings, but may do so where insufficient or no responsive bids received."

Accordingly, the SPOC through SPOC RESOLUTION 0571 of 5 September 2024, having reviewed the Accounting Officer's submission in terms of section 54 (10) of the PPDPA Act [Chapter 22:23], RESOLVED on Tender Number COG/FA/03/05/2024 as follows:
