WELCOME REMARKS

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting. He explained that the purpose of the meeting was to receive evaluation minutes from the evaluation committee meeting and advice according to the PPDPA Act and general regulations. Everyone should participate in this meeting.

BACKGROUND

In terms of section 31: 1c of the PPDPA act 5/2017 all bids from eligible and qualified bidders are assessed according to the same criteria. The tenders were advertised in the Government gazette, EGP portal and the Sunday mail inviting domestic competitive bidders. Council needs to construct Lowlands primary School, two blocks, stage one and two are being completed so bidders will start on stage 3 labour only.

COMMENTS

One of the seven companies which responded did not meet the requirements, however six companies met all requirements. Evaluation committee noticed that some of the bidders attached current cr6 certificates which indicates list of directors and secretaries which have the same information as that in cr14 and cr5 which have same information as in cr6. The committee further agreed to seek clarity from the procurement experts, it was clarified that there is no law at the moment which force companies to abide with new company's act so those documents worked the same. Therefore, the committee agreed to accept both documents as long as the information required is there. The technician also emphasized on site visits to the referenced addresses so that we will be sure about quality of work done by bidders.

RECOMMENDATION

PMU recommended to award the tender to Boltrec Engineering because it met all requirements and had the lowest bid price of USD25 345.24 proposed by S. Chavizha and seconded by A. Zimirenyika.

There being no other business the meeting ended at 08:30hrs.
