1. BACKGROUND

The Airports Company of Zimbabwe (Private) Limited (ACZ) adopted and published a request for proposal through the electronic Government Procurement System (e-GP), the Request for Proposal (RFP) for the Provision of Airport Master Planning Services; Procurement Reference: **ACZ/INTERNATIONAL/0022/2025**. The tender closed on 25 June 2025 on the e-GP system and two Bids were received from:

- i. Haskoning DHV Nederland B,V operating as Netherlands Airport Consultants (NACO).
- ii. International Air Transport Association Consulting (IATA)

In compliance with the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act [Chapter 22:23] ("the Act"), the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (General) Regulations (Statutory Instrument No. 5 of 2018) ("the Regulations") and the General Conditions of Contract for the Procurement of Consultancy Services, ACZ hereby invited Internationally interested firms to develop Airport Master Planning Services.

2. LOTS AND PACKAGES

The procurement requirement was divided into two (2) lots as indicated in Statement of Requirements. Bidders were allowed to bid for all two (2) Lots, but award was limited to one Bidder per lot. A 0,5% price variation was allowed if one (1) Bidder was successful on more than one (1) Lot. ACZ would reserve the right to award any successful bidder if it was deemed to add value to the procuring entity. The Lots were as follows:

- e) a summary of experience in similar assignments, together with the names and contact details of persons connected with these assignments who will provide references.

4. Preparation of Financial Proposal

The Financial Proposal was to:

- a) include the comprehensive cost of providing the services and all related costs.
- b) split the costs indicated above per each airport being tendered for.
