Provision of Consultancy Services for Wastewater Transactional Advisor: Tender ID: 48280 (Tender Reference Number: COH/HW/S29/2025)

City of Harare received one bid from Genesis Global Financial Services on the EGP platform. This Tender was opened on the 26th of January 2026. The Bid Evaluation Committee then commenced on the 27th of January 2026 and completed on the 29th of January 2026.

Evaluation Criteria was categorized as follows:

1. Mandatory Evaluation
2. Technical Evaluation

A) Mandatory Evaluation

Mandatory Criteria was as follows:

- Valid tax clearance certificate
- Ability to carry out the project attach relevant experience
- Current six calendar months' bank statements preceding tender closing date
- Three signed traceable trade reference letters for similar products
- Vat certificate or proof of vat registration
- CR14 / CR6
- CR6 / CR5
- Work plan
- Signed technical proposal submission sheet
- Methodology
- Availability of and adequacy of proposed staff attach CVs of key personnel

Genesis Global Financial Services passed the mandatory evaluation and proceeded to technical evaluation

Total Technical Score = 93 out of 110 (which is 85%)

The evaluation committee has scored **fairly, on an evidence-based interpretation** of the evaluation criteria. Full marks were allocated only where requirements are explicitly met in the attachments. Partial or zero scores reflect genuine gaps in documented commitments rather than assumptions.

Evaluation criteria detailed what the Transactional Advisor will have to do during implementation and the Transactional Advisor at this stage had to submit how he will implement the requirement which was satisfactory.

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


Genesis Global Financial Services passed the Technical Evaluation with a score of 85% which was above minimum required score of 75%.
